Yorkville English Academy guarantees that you will have the time of your life at the Winter Youth Program! Come meet new friends in the wonderful, safe city of Toronto, Ontario.

Winter in Toronto is magical. After a fresh snow fall make a snowman or join your new friends for a toboggan ride down a local hill. Toronto is cold with an average temperature of 0 degrees celsius. But if you dress for the weather, Toronto is a wonderful city to visit.

Learn new skills such as skating, cross country skiing, downhill skiing or snowboarding, dog sledding or just playing in the snow.

Our program is designed for youth ages 8 – 17 years of age. Students are provided with an excellent opportunity to improve their English skills during classes in the morning. In the afternoon and on weekends, students will experience Toronto and surrounding areas such as Niagara Falls, dog sledding in Algonquin Park, and skiing or snowboarding in Collingwood, Ontario.

Students will stay in homes with Canadian families. Our families have been carefully screened to assure a safe, warm and happy environment. Students are provided with a private bedroom and usually a shared washroom. Three nutritious meals are provided daily. Students will be given a packed lunch to bring to school. The school has support staff in case of any difficulties the student encounters during his or her homestay.

Students must abide by the family rules and will sign a contract on the first day of school. **Students in homestay are responsible for their own transportation costs to and from the school.**

If the student is younger, we place two students in the same homestay so that the student never needs to travel alone. Yorkville English Academy is dedicated to making all students feel safe and secure at all times. If a student is absent a staff member contacts the host family to inquire into the reason of their absence.

Students who participate in the Winter Youth Program must have medical insurance which can be purchased at Yorkville English Academy for approximately \$2.00 CD per day.

Participation consent forms, completed by a legal guardian, are required by all applicants. Students will not be allowed to participate in the program until all forms have been received by Yorkville English Academy.

Trip Destinations and Descriptions

Following you will find a brief description of some of the wonderful, exciting activities that you will participate in during your stay in Toronto. While on the activities, English is the only language spoken.

Yorkville English Academy reserves the right to change or cancel any trip or activity due to unfavorable weather conditions or any other circumstances beyond our control. **Please check activity calendar for activities available in your program choice.**

1. **Royal Ontario Museum** – Archaeological digging, bat caves, dinosaurs, volcanoes, costumes, the Bird Gallery and mummies from Ancient Egypt. The ROM exhibits both old and current history in practical ways.
2. **CN Tower** – Toronto’s most famous landmark, and the world’s tallest building.
3. **Niagara Falls** – The Falls are located 130 kilometers from Toronto. Enjoy the town of Niagara Falls for great souvenirs. On the way home we visit the quaint town of Niagara-on-the-Lake.
4. **Toronto Zoo** – Five thousand creatures all together in one place! Rated as one of the top zoos in the world. During winter we visit the animals that are housed indoors.
5. **Ontario Science Center** – The Science Center combines fun with learning. Very much a hands, ears, and eyes-on experience. Also, a movie in the Omnimax Theatre, an exciting screen spread over the vast surface of a dome, with awesome sound and visual effects.
6. **Casa Loma** – Toronto’s famous castle, the former estate of Sir Henry Pellatt, is complete with decorated suites, secret passages, towers, an 800-foot tunnel, stables and wonderful gardens.
7. **City TV and Much Music Tour** – Toronto’s premier television and music station. Join a fun-filled tour and see how the news is presented to the viewer.
8. **Rock Climbing at Joe Rockheads** – Learn to rock climb at an indoor facility. Lesson and equipment provided.
9. **Dog Sledding at Algonquin Park** - Enjoy an afternoon tour of Algonquin Park headed by Huskie dogs. You will learn to guide the sleigh and prepare the dogs for the journey. A great winter activity!
10. **National Film Board Animation Workshop** – This workshop is designed to introduce the student to animation where they will be able to create an animated character and produce a short film using the character. Students can also view animation on state-of-the-art personal viewing stations.
11. **Skating at City Hall** – Skate on a natural ice rink in front of the Toronto City Hall under the festive lights. Skate rentals included.
12. **Collingwood Ski Resort** – Have fun skiing or snowboarding at one of the great resorts in Collingwood, Ontario. Students will be staying at a ski chalet with staff members and will have ESL classes during the morning and ski or snowboard lessons in the afternoon with free time to practice their new skills.

WINTER ON BLUE MOUNTAIN

Blue Mountain is Ontario's Largest Mountain Resort. At 720 vertical feet and 2 ½ miles wide, Blue Mountain is a snow sport paradise providing skiers and snowboarders of all levels a wide variety of terrain. The resort is action packed with 34 trails over 253 acres ranging from beginner to double black diamond, 3 terrain parks, 3 half-pipes including 2 super-pipes, a snow tubing park and 12 lifts, including 4 high speed express chairs to move you uphill fast.
